ACBC Keynote Speaker **Patrick Lencioni** is founder and president of The Table Group, a firm dedicated to providing organizations with ideas, products and services that improve teamwork, clarity and employee engagement. Mr. Lencioni is the author of nine best-selling books with nearly three million copies sold. **Dr. Bill Thierfelder** is President of Belmont Abbey College, a Catholic Liberal Arts College near Charlotte, NC.
